Liberty invests in infrastructure to maintain water quality and provide safe, reliable water service to customers for generations to come.





#### **Liberty's Water System**

Liberty operates and maintains a complex water system to provide safe, reliable water to customers when they need it. The system includes:

- 480 miles of pipeline
- 23 wells
- 8 booster pump stations
- 12 million gallons of storage reservoirs and tank capacity



## **Building for the Future**

Liberty diligently maintains its water system today to protect service for current and future generations. Deferring maintenance can undermine the reliability of the system over time and lead to unplanned disruptions from line breaks, which are more costly than planned replacements.



## $^{+\,\%}_{ imes\,=}$ General Rate Case

Liberty filed a General Rate Case application on January 2, 2024 with the California Public Utilities Commission for the years 2025–2027. The application seeks funding for proposed infrastructure projects in 2025, 2026 and 2027 through a rate adjustment of 10.14% on July 1, 2025, 6.31% in 2026, and 6.18% in 2027 for residential and commercial customers.



### **Upcoming Projects** Proposed in the 2025-2027 General Rate Case

Liberty has proposed to invest nearly \$63.9 million for infrastructure improvements from 2024-2027, which includes:

- Replacing approximately 11.1 miles of aging water main to improve system reliability
- Installing improvements to existing reservoirs to meet code requirements and help prevent corrosion
- Replacing miscellaneous well disinfection equipment and installing new groundwater wells
- Replacing/installing 131 fire hydrants to help protect the community during fire events
- Replacing/installing 2,340 service connections throughout the system to minimize leaks and water loss
- Replacing/installing 212 water system valves
