🚫 Liberty's Water System

Liberty operates and maintains a complex water system to provide safe, reliable water to customers when they need it. The system includes:

- 264 miles of pipeline
- 12 wells
- 8 booster pump stations
- 6.9 million gallons of storage reservoirs and tank capacity
- 7 purchased water connections

🕖 Building for the Future

Liberty diligently maintains its water system today to protect service for current and future generations. Deferring maintenance can undermine the reliability of the system over time and lead to unplanned disruptions from line breaks, which are more costly than planned replacements.

$+ \%_{\times =}$ General Rate Case

Liberty filed a General Rate Case application on January 2, 2024 with the California Public Utilities Commission for the years 2025–2027. The application seeks funding for proposed infrastructure projects in 2025, 2026 and 2027 through a rate adjustment of 22.08% on July 1, 2025, 4.24% in 2026, and 3.96% in 2027 for residential and commercial customers.

Upcoming Projects Proposed in the 2025-2027 General Rate Case

Liberty has proposed to invest nearly \$72.5 million to maintain and improve infrastructure from 2024-2027, which includes:

- Replacing approximately 8.3 miles of an aging water main to improve system reliability
- Installing improvements to existing reservoirs to meet code requirements
- Upgrading and replacing four electrical motor control centers, motor drives, and a pressure tank, and other miscellaneous production site improvements
- Replacing miscellaneous well disinfection equipment, install new groundwater well, and well treatment systems to address emerging contaminants
- Replacing/installing 1,555 service connections throughout the system to minimize leaks and water loss
- Replacing/installing 317 fire hydrants to protect the community during fire events
- Replacing/installing 416 water system valves
