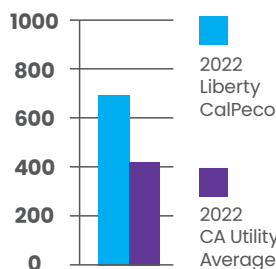

What is the California Credit?

This month your electric bill will include a credit identified as the "California Climate Credit." Your household and many others throughout the State will receive this credit on your utility bills. This electric credit is typically distributed in April and October.

The California Climate Credit is part of California's efforts to fight climate change. This credit is from the California Cap-and-Trade program, which requires power plants, fuel providers, and large industrial facilities that emit greenhouse gases to buy carbon pollution allowances.
