Subject: Base Revenue Requirement Balancing Account ("BRRBA") Reallocation

Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933 E) ("Liberty CalPeco") hereby submits this **Tier 2** Advice Letter No. 91-E requesting the authority to change the rates charged to customers in its Base Revenue Requirement Balancing Account ("BRRBA") in accordance with Section 8 of the Preliminary Statement in Liberty CalPeco's tariff. Liberty CalPeco originally submitted and received approval of Advice Letters 91-E, which were approved by the Energy Division on July 23, 2018. Liberty CalPeco implemented the new rate component effect August 1, 2018.

I. Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to request the authority to change the BRRBA rates by customer class to more fairly collect the BRRBA under-collection.

II. Background

In accordance with Liberty CalPeco's tariffs, Liberty CalPeco is authorized to maintain the BRRBA, which records the difference between Liberty CalPeco's authorized annual base rate revenue requirement and the recorded annual revenue from base rates.

In AL-91-E, Liberty CalPeco requested and received authorization to recover the BRRBA undercollection of \$9,026,803 over a 24-month period. The allocation of BRRBA was done by customer class, based on the individual over- or under-collection for each customer class, which resulted in wildly fluctuating rates by customer class.

III. Request

A. Change in Allocations of BRRBA Undercollection

The BRRBA rates as approved in AL-91-E were calculated based on the individual over- and under-collections by customer class. This allocation methodology resulted in wildly fluctuating BRRBA rates by customer class. Liberty CalPeco is requested authorization to change BRRBA rates to equally recover the BRRBA balance from all customers by calculating a rate based on total kWh sales. This calculation results in one BRRBA rate for all customer classes, with the exception

of A-3. A-3's BRRBA rate is slightly lower because it is not appropriate to recover the undercollection of vegetation management costs from A-3, as A-3 pays a monthly flat rate for vegetation management.

Liberty CalPeco is requesting recovery of the BRRBA as set forth in Table 1 below. The new rate results in an average annual increase of 5.27% to overall authorized revenue requirement.
