# **Summary**

The purpose of this advice letter is to implement rates for escalation year 2020 as authorized by the Commission in Ordering Paragraph No. 8 of D.20-09-019 (A.18-01-002, et al.).

The escalation year 2020 revenue increase of \$1,462,376 or 5.94% was calculated using the adopted quantities from D.20-09-019 in accordance with the procedures contained in the Rate Case Plan for Class A water utilities (D.07-05-062, Section VII. Escalation and Attrition Advice Letter Procedure). The Commission Staff has been provided with workpapers showing the calculation of the escalation year increase.

The adopted rate of return of 7.35%, specified in D.20-09-019 was adjusted to 7.49% to coincide with the pro-forma 12-month period ending March 31, 2021. A summary of earnings for this period, on both a pro-forma and recorded basis, is contained in the workpapers.

The pro-forma rate of return of 6.81% is less than the adjusted rate of return of 7.49% specified in D.20-09-019. A summary of earnings for this period, on both a pro-forma and recorded basis, is contained in the workpapers.

Liberty Apple Valley also includes an update to the adopted quantities for the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism Balancing Account and the Modified Cost Balancing Account, and Yermo Water Revenue Balancing Account for escalation year 2021 contained in the Preliminary Statement.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 8 of D.20-09-019, this escalation filing is classified as a Tier 1 advice letter.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

# **Requested Effective Date**

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 8 of D.20-09-019, Liberty Apple Valley requests this filing become effective July 1, 2021.

# **Notice and Service**

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on May 17, 2021 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Customer notification of this rate increase was previously accomplished in A.18-01-002, et al. as required by Rule No. 3.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Additional public notice of this filing is not required.

## **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

- 5. Liberty Apple Valley will record the accumulated YWRBA Balance monthly, by adding the entry in Section 4.C. to the prior accumulated monthly balance. Liberty Apple Valley shall apply interest to the average net balance in the YWRBA at a rate calculated 1/12 of the most recent month's interest rate on commercial paper (non-financial, 3-month), published in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15, (http://www.federalreserve.gov/releases/H15/), or its successor (debit or credit). Accumulated interest will be included in the amount on which interest is charged, but will be identified as a separate component of the YWRBA.

The YWRBA shall have the effective date of July 1, 2019.
