

Summary

The purpose of this advice letter filing is to add new tariff rate schedules for the Yermo Water Company ("Yermo") service area consistent with the interim rate plan described in AVR Advice Letter 189-W. The new tariff rate schedules include the special conditions contained in AVR's tariff Schedule No. 1 with the exception of the temporary surcharges and sur-credits related to AVR's regulatory accounts. This advice letter filing amends AVR's service area maps to reflect the Yermo service area being added to its tariff.

Background

On December 5, 2013, AVR and Yermo, as represented by its court appointed receiver, jointly filed Advice Letter 189-W requesting California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") authorization for a transfer of ownership of Yermo from the court-appointed receiver to AVR. On August 28, 2014, the Commission adopted Resolution W-4998 conditionally authorizing Yermo to sell and AVR to buy the public utility assets of Yermo. Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Resolution W-4998 states the following:

"Resolution 189-W filed by the court-appointed receiver for Yermo Water Company to sell and Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company to buy Yermo Water Company is granted, conditioned on Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company's receipt of a permit from the State Water Resource Control Board to operate Yermo Water Company and receipt of an order from the San Bernardino Superior Court approving the sale of Yermo Water Company to Apple Valley Water."

On September 2, 2015 AVR received a permit from the State Water Resource Control Board to operate Yermo. On June 24, 2015 AVR received an order from the San Bernardino Superior Court approving the sale of Yermo to AVR. AVR has therefore met the conditions of the Commission's conditional authorization described in Resolution W-4998. Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of Resolution W-4998 states the following:

"Within 10 days of the acquisition of Yermo Water Company becoming final, Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company must notify the Director of the Commission's Division of Water and Audits in writing that the acquisition has been completed."

AVR's acquisition of Yermo was completed on August 25, 2015. On September 3, 2015 AVR notified the Director of the Division of Water and Audits that the acquisition was completed.

Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Resolution W-4998 states the following:

"Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company's proposed interim rate plan for the Yermo Water Company service area for the period 2014 through 2017 is approved. Within 30 days of taking ownership of Yermo Water Company, Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company shall file a Tier 1 advice letter to add a new tariff rate schedule for the Yermo Water Company service area consistent with the interim rate plan described in Advice Letter 189-W and shown in Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company's cancelled Tariff Sheet 762-W. In addition to the rates shown, the new tariff schedule should include the special conditions contained in Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company's tariff Schedule No.1 with the exception of the temporary surcharges and sur-credits related to Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company's regulatory accounts. Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company shall also amend its service area maps and any other provisions in its tariff to reflect that the Yermo Water Company service area is being added to its tariff."

Accordingly, AVR files this advice letter filing to implement new tariff rate schedules applicable to the Yermo water system service area.

Workpapers including a permit to operate the Yermo water system from the State Water Resource Control Board and the order from San Bernardino Superior Court approving the sale of Yermo to AVR have been provided to Division of Water and Audits staff.

Request

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Resolution W-4998, AVR requests Commission authorization to add new tariff schedules No. 1-YE-R General Residential Metered Service and No. 3-YE-NR General Non-Residential Metered Service to its tariffs. AVR also requests Commission authorization to amend its service area maps and other provisions in its tariffs to reflect that the Yermo service area is being added to its tariffs.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to the Resolution W-4998, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, and General Rule 7.3.2, AVR requests this filing become effective on October 1, 2015.

AVR is requesting an effective date of October 1, 2015 to allow for a public meeting to be held in the Yermo service area prior to the effective date of the new rates. AVR is holding a public meeting on September 30, 2015 to discuss the rates that are the subject of this advice letter.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on September 24, 2015 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Yermo customers were previously notified of Advice Letter 189-W by direct mail on December 4, 2013. A public meeting was held in the Yermo service area on July 15, 2015 to provide customers with an overview of AVR services and processes including the rate schedules that are the subject of this advice letter filing.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) ~~The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or~~
is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:



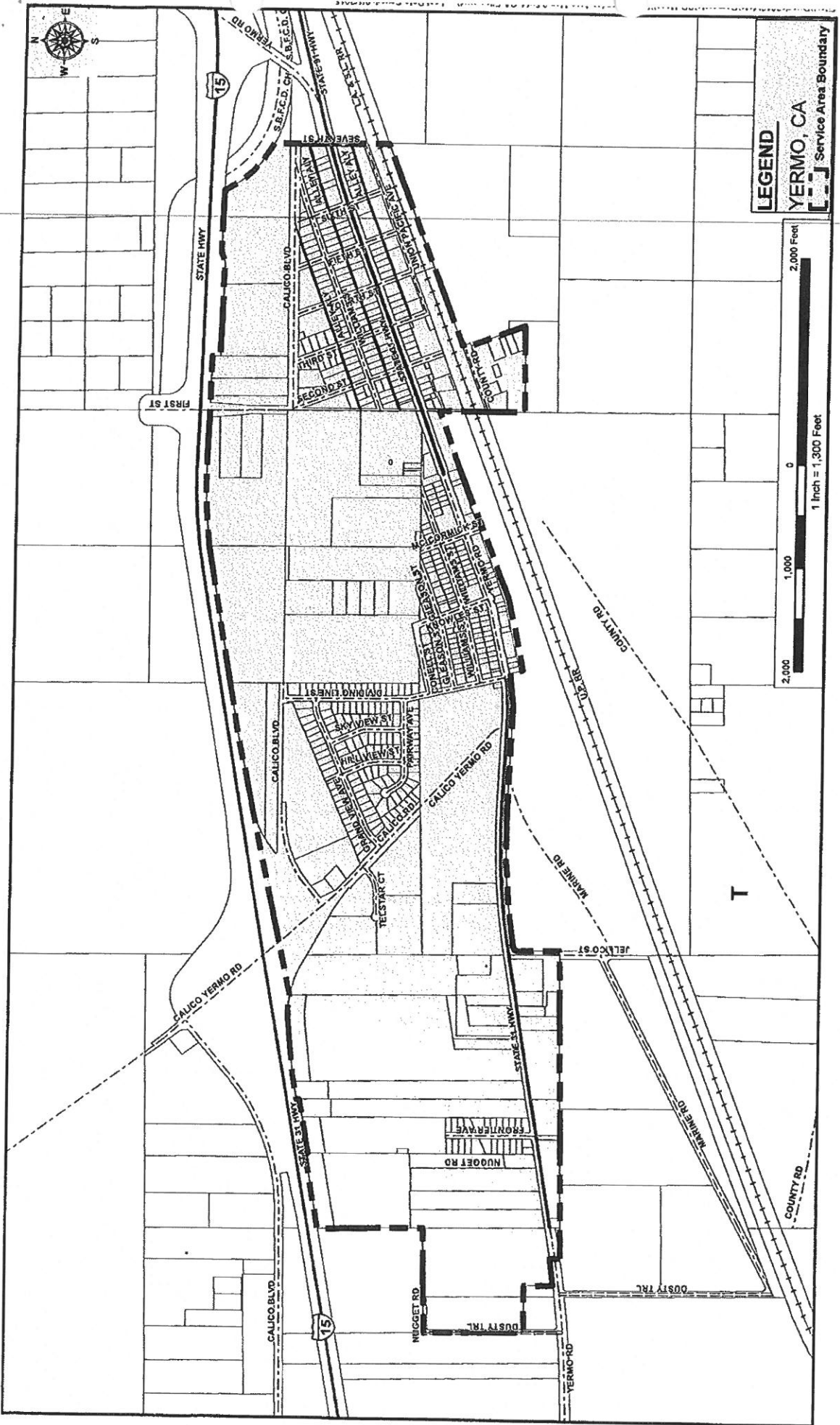

Service hereunder is for private fire systems which are regularly inspected by the local fire protection agency having jurisdiction and to which no connection for other than fire suppression purposes shall be made. Service shall be installed according to specifications of the utility and shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the utility. The utility will install the detector meter listed by the Underwriters Laboratories, Inc. or other device to indicate unauthorized use, leakage, or waste of water. The cost of such installation and the cost of the meter or other device shall be paid by the applicant.
5. The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of its system.

Customers will be charged a monthly service charge at the applicable mere size rate reflected in Schedule No. 1, Residential General Metered Service. Customers will receive a monthly CARW Credit of \$7.46 prorated based on days of service, if service is not provided for a full month.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. CARW Household: A CARW Household is a household where the total gross income from all sources is less than or equal to the maximum household income levels for the CARE programs approved by the Commission as reflected on Form No. 13, California Alternative Rates for Water (CARW) Application. Total gross income shall include income from all sources, both taxable and non-taxable. Persons who are claimed as a dependent on another person's income tax return (other than your spouse) are not eligible for this program.
