SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The fire protection service connection shall be installed by the utility with the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
- 2. The minimum diameter for fire protection service shall be two (2) inches, and the maximum diameter shall be not more than the diameter of the main to which the service is connected.
- 3. If a distribution main of adequate size to serve a private fire protection system in addition to all other normal service does not exist in the street or alley adjacent to the premises to be served, then a service main from the nearest main of adequate capacity shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
- 4. Service hereunder is for private fire systems which are regularly inspected by the local fire protection agency having jurisdiction and to which no connection for other than fire suppression purposes shall be made. Service shall be installed according to specifications of the utility and shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the utility. The utility will install the detector meter listed by the Underwriters Laboratories, Inc. or other device to indicate unauthorized use, leakage, or waste of water. The cost of such installation and the cost of the meter or other device shall be paid by the applicant.
- 5. The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of its system.

- 6. Any unauthorized use of water, other than for fire extinguishing purposes shall be charged for at the regular established rate as set forth under Schedule No. 3, Non-Residential General Metered Service, and/or may be the grounds for the immediate disconnection of the service without liability to the Company.
- 7. A late charge will be imposed per Schedule No. LC.
- 8. All bills subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
- 9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.277 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12-months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 248-W. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the following regulatory accounts as of December 31, 2017: Income Tax Repair Regulations Implementation Memorandum Account, Low Income Customer Data Sharing Cost Memorandum Account, Cost of Capital Memorandum Account, Interim Rates Memorandum Account, 2014 Water Conservation Memorandum Account, and the Residual balances for various balancing and memorandum accounts approved for Recovery in Advice Letter 177-W and Advice Letter 210-W.
- 10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$4.43 surcredit per customer is to be added to the Customer's bill for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 248-W. This surcredit will refund the over collection in the Employee and Retiree Healthcare Balancing Account and Tangible Property Regulations Consequences Memorandum Account as of December 31, 2017.
- 11. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$4.06 surcredit per customer is to be added to the Customer's bill for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 248-W. This surcredit will refund the over-collection in the Pension Expense Balancing Account as of December 31, 2017.
- 19. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.078 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 16 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 249-W. This surcharge will recover the under collection in the Interim Rates Memorandum Account as of November 19, 2020.
- 20. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.235 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 24 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 274-W. This surcharge will recover the undercollection in the Interim Rates Memorandum Account as of April 30, 2023.
- 21. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a one-time surcredit is to be added to the Customer's bill beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 275-W-A. This surcredit is to refund the over collection in the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act Memorandum Account as of June 30, 2022.

This surcharge will recover the under-collection in the Yermo Water Revenue Balancing Account as of June 30, 2022. This surcharge is only applicable to Yermo customers.
