

Top 10 Holiday Lighting Tips

- Switch to safe, long-lasting, energy-efficient LED holiday lights.
- Use a timer to reliably turn lights on and off.
- Don't overload your electric circuits.
- Stay within limits of your circuit breaker.
- Adhere to manufacturer's designations and locations for indoor vs. outdoor use.
- Don't run extension cords under rugs, around furniture legs, or across doorways.

- Avoid stringing more than three sets of lights together and plugging into single outlet.
- Make sure there's a bulb in each socket of a light string even if it's burned out.
- Keep your natural trees well-watered to prevent bulbs from igniting dry branches.
- Never use electrical decorations on metal trees.
