What Our Customers Need to Know About Greenhouse Gases (GHG)

In 2006, the California Legislature passed AB 32 which acknowledged global warming and established the goal to reduce the state's carbon footprint to 1990 levels. To meet this mandate, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requires all investor-owned utilities to participate in their "Cap and Trade" program which meets the requirements of AB 32. Liberty Utilities is regulated by the CPUC and, as such, will be participating in this program.

What Does This Mean to You?

Ultimately, it will mean cleaner energy that produces less GHG. The CPUC requires both utilities and consumers to make changes that will affect how energy is produced, as well as the cost of that energy.

When Will Changes Occur?

We anticipate the CPUC will require implementation of billing changes effective in the first quarter of 2014.
