WHAT MAKES UP MY RATE?

Utility rates aren't always the easiest to understand, as many of our customers tell us.

As a regulated utility, each component of Liberty's rates is mandated, audited, and authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission.

Rate tariff sheets are posted on our website providing detailed breakdown for each rate class (click on the "Customer Support" tab and select the "Billing and Payment" link).

As this graph shows, 88.7% of the average residential rate is simply a pass through for costs incurred to provide service to our customers (Liberty recovers dollar for dollar with no profit).

And, 50% of that is for energy costs alone (again with no profit). The balance, or 11.3%, is actually the CPUC-allowed return to the stockholders to compensate them for their investment.



Note: All costs except for return on equity component is a direct pass through of Liberty's costs.
