Checklist

I. Purpose

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 20 of Decision ("D.") 18-09-034, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933 E) ("Liberty CalPeco") hereby submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter No. 140-E to describe its efforts to comply with the Transportation Electrification ("TE") Safety Requirements Checklist.

II. Background

On September 27, 2018, the Commission issued D.18-09-034, which approved various TE projects Liberty CalPeco proposed in A.17-06-033. Liberty CalPeco's approved projects include a DCFC project, a residential and small business charger installation rebate programs, and an EV bus infrastructure program.

Ordering Paragraph 20 of D.18-09-034 requires the sponsoring utility for each approved project to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter containing an attestation signed by the project manager describing efforts to comply with the Safety Requirements Checklist provided as a link in the Decision.¹

III. Discussion

Liberty CalPeco's TE programs comply with the Safety Requirements Checklist included in D.18-09-034. Liberty CalPeco has not started construction on the DCFC installations, but will include in all contracts the requirement to comply with all components of the Safety Requirement Checklist. For the residential and small business charger installation rebate programs, those requesting rebates must prove that the installed equipment meets nationally recognized testing requirements and was installed by a licensed electrical contractor.

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The required attestation from Liberty CalPeco's project manager is attached.

Liberty CalPeco requests that this **Tier 1** advice letter become effective as of March 30, 2020.
