Subject: Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U-933 E) – Implementation of the Rule 20 Balancing Account

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph ("OP") 12 of California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") Decision ("D.") 21-06-013, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC ("Liberty") hereby submits this Tier 1 advice letter to implement the Rule 20 Balancing Account, effective July 6, 2021.

Purpose

In compliance with OP 12 of D.21-06-013, Liberty submits this advice letter to implement the Rule 20 Balancing Account. The proposed tariff sheets are attached.

Background

In OP 12 of D.21-06-013, the CPUC ordered the Utilities to:

[E]ach file a Tier 1 advice letter to establish and/or modify an existing Rule 20 one-way balancing account, with subaccounts for each of its Rule 20 programs within 30 days of the effective date of this decision. Each account shall track all costs to be included in the Rule 20 Annual Report, in addition to any figures typically tracked in a balancing account.

The proposed balancing account tariff is attached.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to OP 5 of D.21-06-013, this Advice Letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective Date

Liberty requests that this Tier 1 advice filing become effective today, July 6, 2021.

Protests

These amounts will be tracked separately for each Rule 20 project in a separate subaccount.
