Subject: Liberty’s Building Decarbonization Compliance Update for New and Upsized Electric Service Lines

Purpose:

Pursuant to California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) or (Commission) Decision (D.) 25-06-034, Ordering Paragraphs (OPs) 7 and 11, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (Liberty) submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter providing compliance reporting for 2025 new service line installations and existing service line upsizing or replacement projects.

Background

On September 13, 2018, Governor Jerry Brown signed into law Senate Bill (SB) 1477 (Stern, Chapter 378, Statutes 2018), to promote California’s building-related greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reduction goals. In response to the enactment of SB 1477, the Commission initiated Rulemaking (R.) 19-01-011. On June 20, 2026, the Commission issued D.25-06-034, Phase 4 Track A Decision, establishing new electric service line upsizing rules and reporting requirements and implementing Assembly Bill 157.

Compliance Reporting

In accordance with OPs 7 and 11 of D.25-06-034, Liberty collects service line capacities for (1) any new electric service lines installed in new construction and (2) any electric service lines replacing existing service lines.

The table below shows the results for January 1 through December 31, 2025.
