Subject: Modifications to the Small Business California Climate Credit Distribution Methodology Compliance Filing 2025

Purpose

Pursuant to Resolution E-5339, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (Liberty) submits this Tier 1 advice letter to provide eligibility changes resulting from the Small Business California Climate Credit (SBCCC) eligibility review per Ordering Paragraphs (OPs) 2, 3, and 5.

Summary

Liberty has identified one Small Business customer in its service territory no longer eligible to receive the SBCCC due to 100 or more accounts. Liberty is directed to implement changes to eligibility for the SBCCC as soon as possible and no later than April 1, 2025 following notification to the SBCCC recipient outlining changes to eligibility requirements. Liberty is providing this eligibility change to Energy Division via a Tier 1 advice letter as a result of an eligibility review.

Background

On August 28, 2024, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued Resolution E-5339 to modify the SBCCC distribution methodology. The proposed outcomes of the resolution are as follows:

 Changes the eligibility criteria used by the investor-owned utilities (IOUs) to ensure prudency in the distribution of the Small Business California Climate Credit. Energy Division Tariff Unit California Public Utilities Commission March 21, 2025 Page 2

- Recipients with 100 or more eligible accounts under the existing usage criteria are no longer eligible to receive the Small Business California Climate Credit on any account.
- Establishes notification requirements by IOUs to newly ineligible recipients.
- Establishes notification requirements by IOUs to Energy Division for eligibility changes.¹

The existing definition of a small business is as follows: "Any non-residential customer on a General Service or Agricultural tariff with demand not exceeding 20 kW in more than three months in the previous 12-month period is considered to be a small business." Liberty has identified one small business customer in its service territory with greater than 100 accounts, no longer eligible to receive the SBCCC. Liberty is notifying the customer as far in advance as possible before implementing modification of the distribution methodology.

Effective Date

Liberty requests that this Tier 1 Advice Letter be effective as of April 1, 2025.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, and Resolution E-5339, this Advice Letter is being submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Protests:

Anyone wishing to protest this advice letter may do so by letter sent via U.S. mail, facsimile, or email, any of which must be received no later than April 10, 2025, which is 20 days after the date of this advice letter.
