**Subject:** Customer First Cost Recovery

Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933 E) ("Liberty") hereby submits this **Tier 2** Advice Letter to increase its base rate revenues in accordance with Ordering Paragraph ("OP") 9 of Decision ("D.") 23-04-043.

#### I. Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to adjust Liberty's base rates in accordance with OP 9 of D.23-04-043), which states that "Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC shall recover costs associated with the Customer First and Advanced Metering Infrastructure via a Tier 2 advice letter once the projects are considered used and useful and subject to the capital expense totals specified in the Revenue Requirement Settlement Agreement."

Customer First was considered used and useful in October 2023. The total costs specified in the Revenue Requirement Settlement Agreement, approved in D.23-04-043, was \$23,350,880.

#### II. Customer First

#### A. Eligible Capital Expenditures

The Customer First Project is the implementation of a comprehensive enterprise-wide solution to replace and improve legacy computer systems. These include systems related to customer information, finance and accounting, network operations, procurement, and accounts payable, employee time, and payroll services. D.23-04-043 authorized a maximum capital expenditure of \$23,350,880 for the Customer First project. The project was completed and placed into service in October 2023 at a total cost exceeding the authorized maximum capital expenditure. Liberty calculated 2023 and 2024 revenue requirements for the authorized \$23,350,880.

#### B. 2023 and 2024 Revenue Requirement Calculations

Liberty calculated a 2023 revenue requirement of \$586,019 and a 2024 revenue requirement of \$3,602,098, which includes the depreciation expense, federal and state income taxes, and a return based on the 7.06% rate of return authorized in Liberty's 2022 GRC Decision. The following table summarizes the revenue requirement calculation.

#### III. Rates

Application of Liberty's Customer First request results in a proposed 2024 base rate revenue ("BRR") increase of \$3.602 million, or 3.19%, as shown in the table below. Upon approval, Liberty will submit an Advice Letter to update rates based on the approved BRR increase and any other rate changes approved between now and its submission.

Liberty also requests authority to record the 2023 BRR amount of \$586,019 to its Base Revenue Requirement Balancing Account ("BRRBA") for future recovery through Liberty's BRRBA surcharge.
