Subject: Modification for Small Business Schedules from Volumetric to Flat Climate Credit per Decision 21-08-026

Purpose

Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933-E) ("Liberty") submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter to set the volumetric rates to zero for the California Climate Credit in Section 20, Greenhouse Gas Revenue Balancing Account ("GHGRBA"). This change is being requested in accordance with California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Decision (D.) 21-08-026. The affected tariff sheet is included in Attachment A.

Background

The Commission's Rulemaking (R.) 20-05-002 reviewed electric utility customer climate credits provided through the California Air Resources Board's (CARB's) Cap-and-Trade Program. As a result, the Commission issued D.21-08-026 modified the Small Business California Climate Credit from the current volumetric format to a flat rate format to align with CARB Regulation, with the timing of distribution mirroring the semi-annual Residential California Climate Credit.

This advice letter requests to modify the company's existing California Climate Credit rate and set the Small Business volumetric climate credit to zero starting January 1, 2022. Simultaneously, the company anticipates filing early in 2022 for an update to this tariff to implement the per-customer, semi-annual Small Business California Climate Credit upon approval of the company's 2022 California Climate Credit in its Energy Cost Adjustment Clause (ECAC) proceeding, filed under Application (A.) 21-08-003. Liberty is anticipating receiving approval and making a compliance filing for this additional change in time for both residential and small business customers to receive the flat California Climate Credit starting in April 2022. Turning off the volumetric Small Business California Climate Credit beginning January 1, 2022

in conjunction with beginning the distribution of the semi-annual per-customer Small Business California Climate Credit in April 2022 will result in the proper, Commission-approved distribution of the California Climate Credit to small business customers starting in 2022.

Effective Date

Liberty requests that this Tier 1 advice letter be effective as of January 1, 2022.

Protests
