In accordance with Affiliate Transaction Rule (Rule) VI.B adopted in Decision (D.)97-12-088, Appendix A, dated December 16, 1997, and modified by D.98-08-035, D.98-12-075, D.99-09-002, and D.02-02-046, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC ("Liberty CalPeco") hereby submits this advice letter to provide notice to the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") of the creation of new affiliates.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this advice filing is to provide notice to the Commission, pursuant to Rule VI.B, of the creation of the affiliates listed in Attachment A.

BACKGROUND

D.97-12-088, as subsequently modified by various decisions, adopted rules governing the relationship between California's natural gas local distribution companies and electric utilities and certain of their affiliates. For purposes of an electric utility, the rules apply to all utility transactions with affiliates engaging in the provision of a product that uses electricity or services that relate to the use of electricity, unless otherwise exempted by the rules.

No unusual or unique circumstances exist that would require affiliate transaction rule implementation measures for these affiliates beyond those already identified by the utility. Therefore, Liberty CalPeco will apply the provisions of its 2017 Compliance Plan, filed on June 30, 2017 via Advice Letter No. 79-E, to all transactions with these affiliates. If the Commission modifies or requires amendments to Liberty CalPeco's current and prevailing compliance plan, or in the event that Liberty CalPeco files an update to its compliance plan, Liberty CalPeco will apply all such changes or the provisions of such amended plans to these affiliates.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Liberty CalPeco requests that this **Tier 1** Advice Letter be effective as of June 22, 2018.



On March 9, 2018, Algonquin Power & Utilities Corp., the ultimate parent of Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC, formed a joint venture, Abengoa-Algonquin Global Energy Solutions B.V. ("AAGES"), with Seville, Spain-based Abengoa S.A. (MCE: ABG) ("Abengoa") that will be focused on the development and construction of global clean energy and water infrastructure assets. AAGES is 50% owned by Algonquin (AY Holdco) B.V., a direct subsidiary of Algonquin Power & Utilities Corp., and 50% owned by Abengoa S.A. through a subsidiary.

On March 9, 2019, a subsidiary of AAGES, AAGES (AY Holdings) B.V., acquired a 25% equity interest in Atlantica Yield plc (NASDAQ: AY). AY is the upstream owner of Mojave Solar LLC. Mojave Solar LLC owns the Mojave Solar Project, a 250 MW net (280 gross) solar generation facility located in San Bernardino County, California. The Mojave Solar Project began commercial operation in the first half of 2014 and is located within the California Independent System Operator, Inc. (CAISO) BAA. The Mojave Solar Project is an EWG and has received market based rate authority from FERC. All of Mojave Solar Project's net electric capacity is contractually committed to PG&E pursuant to a long-term power purchase agreement. Mojave Solar LLC's sole member is Mojave Solar Holdings LLC, a direct subsidiary of ASHUSA Inc., which is wholly owned by AY.
