**Subject: Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U-933 E) – Notification of Addition of
New Event to Wildfire Expense Memorandum Account**

Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933-E) (“Liberty”) submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter to add the 2020 Mountain View Fire as a new wildfire event to the Wildfire Expense Memorandum Account (“WEMA”).

Background

On August 13, 2020, Liberty filed its WEMA Application (A.20-08-009) requesting authorization to establish a memorandum account for tracking incremental unreimbursed wildfire liability costs. On November 19, 2020 the Commission issued D.20-11-034, which established the WEMA as an ongoing account, not limited to a particular wildfire event. In Ordering Paragraph (“OP”) 4 of D.20-11-034, the Commission ordered Liberty to notify the Commission via Tier 1 Advice Letter whenever a new specific wildfire event is added to WEMA.

Discussion

Through this Advice Letter, Liberty notifies the Commission that it is adding the 2020 Mountain View Fire as a new wildfire event to the WEMA and will track incremental costs of that event as authorized by D.20-08-009 and Liberty’s applicable WEMA tariff.

Effective Date

Liberty requests that this Tier 1 advice filing become effective upon the date of submission.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by letter sent via U.S. mail, by facsimile or by email, any of which must be received no later than July 1, 2025, which is 20 days after the date of this filing. The protest shall set forth the grounds upon which it is based and shall be submitted expeditiously. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. Protests should be mailed to:
