Subject: Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933-E) – Fee Schedules and Estimated Timeframes for Service Connections for New Housing Construction

#### **Purpose**

Pursuant to Senate Bill (SB) 1210, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933-E) ("Liberty") submits this informational **Tier 1** Advice Letter ("AL").

#### **Background**

Section 1, Chapter 9, 8401.a of SB 1210 reads:

On or before January 1, 2026, for new housing construction, each utility shall publicly post both of the following on its internet website:

- 1) A schedule of estimated fees for typical service connections for each housing development type, including, but not limited to, accessory dwelling unit, multifamily, mixed-use, and single-family developments. This paragraph does not apply to a utility that continues to post a schedule of their fees with this information pursuant to Section 65940.1 of the Government Code.
- 2) The estimated timeframes for completing typical service connections needed for each housing development type, including, but not limited to, accessory dwelling unit, mixed-use, multifamily, and single-family developments.

#### **Compliance**

In compliance with SB 1210, Liberty will post a schedule of estimated fees and timeframes for typical service connections for new housing construction on its public website by January 1, 2026. The schedule will be posted on Liberty's website on the *New Construction Service Application & Standards* webpage. This information only advice letter is being filed by 11/3/2025 in compliance with the request made by Energy Division via email on October 6, 2025.

#### **Effective Date**

Liberty requests that this **Tier 1** advice letter be effective as of January 1, 2026.

#### **Protests**
