



General Rate Case Decision

Prioritizing safe, reliable electric service

On May 28, 2021, Liberty filed its General Rate Case (GRC) application for the years 2022–2024. The application sought California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) approval to fund fixed costs, operational expenses, and critical system investments. Below is a summary of costs authorized by the final decision issued by the CPUC on April 27, 2023. Liberty continues to offer the second-lowest rates in California.

Wildfire Mitigation

Safety is a top priority for Liberty and the CPUC. Wildfire mitigation costs comprise most of Liberty's rate increase.

Infrastructure Improvements

Liberty will make prudent investments in infrastructure to improve service reliability, mitigate wildfire risk, and reduce the need for public safety power shutoffs (PSPS) by:

- Installing covered conductors (insulated wire)
- Replacing conventional fuses with limiting fuses
- Testing and replacing poles that have reached the end of their useful lifespan
- Enhancing grid topology

Tree Safety and Vegetation Management

In compliance with state laws, Liberty identifies and prunes or removes trees and vegetation to maintain adequate clearance for its power lines. This wildfire mitigation effort occurs year-round along 650 miles of overhead lines in Liberty's service territory.
