Subject: Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933-E) Annual Public Purpose Program Surcharge Adjustment

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraphs 10 and 17 of Decision 14-05-004, Liberty Utilities (CalPeco Electric) LLC (U 933-E) ("Liberty CalPeco") hereby submits this **Tier 2** Advice Letter seeking approval for adjustments to its Public Purpose Program surcharge.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this Advice Letter is to revise Liberty CalPeco's Public Purpose Program surcharges to adjust the California Alternate Rates for Energy ("CARE") Program and the Energy Savings Assistance ("ESA") Program components to reflect current activity pursuant to Ordering Paragraphs 10 and 17 of Decision 14-05-004.

#### **Background**

As of September 30, 2016, Liberty CalPeco's CARE Program is under-collected by (\$192,045). Liberty CalPeco forecasts that the CARE Program under-collection will increase throughout 2017 such that at year end the CARE Program will be under-collected by the amount of (\$271,373).

As of September 30, 2016, Liberty CalPeco's ESA Program is under-collected by (\$21,119). Liberty CalPeco forecasts that the ESA Program under-collection will continue throughout 2017 such that at year end the ESA Program will be under-collected by the amount of (\$16,040).

Liberty CalPeco's forecasts of the current CARE Program Balancing Account and ESA Program Balancing Account are outlined in Exhibit A.

#### Request

To ensure that Liberty CalPeco does not continue to under-collect in 2017, Liberty CalPeco requests an increase to the CARE Program component of the Public Purpose Program surcharge to bring the CARE Balancing Account balance close to zero by December 31, 2017. Accordingly, Liberty CalPeco requests an increase of \$0.00047/kWh to the CARE component, which results in a new rate of \$0.0020/kWh as of January 1, 2017. Based on the requested increase, the forecasted under-collection in the CARE Balancing Account will decrease to \$793 as of December 31, 2017.

Additionally, Liberty CalPeco requests an increase to the ESA Program component of the Public Purpose Program surcharge to bring the ESA Balancing Account balance close to zero by December 31, 2017. Liberty CalPeco requests an increase of \$0.000025/kWh to the ESA component, which results in a new rate of \$0.000375/kWh as of January 1, 2017. Based on the requested increase, the forecasted under-collection in the ESA Balancing Account will decrease to \$690 as of December 31, 2017.

The forecasted impact of the requested adjustments is detailed in Exhibit B.

### **Coordination with Other Pending Liberty CalPeco Rate Proceedings**

Liberty CalPeco concurrently has a General Rate Case ("GRC") application (A.15-05-008), an Energy Cost Adjustment Clause ("ECAC") application (A.16-07-001) ("ECAC Application"), and its 2017 Post-Test Year Adjustment Mechanism ("PTAM") Advice Letter (Advice Letter 65-E) pending before the Commission. Liberty CalPeco currently expects the Commission to issue a final decision in the GRC application on a schedule that would enable the revised GRC rates to become effective as of January 1, 2017. Liberty CalPeco's tariff provides that revisions to ECAC rates and revisions to rates due to the PTAM are also to become effective as of January 1, 2017.

Assuming final decisions are issued in Liberty CalPeco's GRC and ECAC applications on a schedule that enables the revised rates to become effective as of January 1, 2017, and there are no delays in Liberty CalPeco's PTAM Advice Letter, Liberty CalPeco intends to timely make the necessary compliance submissions, including presenting revised tariffs to implement the aggregation of the multiple rate changes and enable the new rates being requested in this Advice Letter, the PTAM Advice Letter, and the GRC and ECAC applications to each become effective

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as of January 1, 2017. The consolidation of these rate changes is intended to minimize the number of rate changes for the customers of Liberty CalPeco.

#### **Protests**


