FALL CONSERVATION TIPS

Adjust:

- Adjust your irrigation controllers when you reset your clocks on Sunday, Nov. 4.
- Water before 9 AM and after 6 PM.
- Turn off irrigation systems before & after periods of rain.

Cut Back:

- Cut back on watering days & times.
- With cooler temperatures, landscapes need less water.
- Overwatering can lead to plant disease.

Invest:

 Invest in a weather-based, smart irrigation system with an automatic rain shutoff device.



START PLANTING

Late September to November starts the most important planting season of the year.

- Plant native and drought tolerant plants; warm soil helps new plants develop deep roots before summer.
- Fall season is a perfect opportunity to transplant Joshua trees and yuccas from late September to October.
- Use organic mulch around plants especially around trees to help retain moisture.
- Prune dead limbs, clean away brush, and clean leaves from gutters to protect against wildfires.
