



Be aware of downed wires

If you see a downed wire, stay a minimum of 30 feet away, which is approximately the length of a school bus. Once you are a safe distance away, report downed wires immediately by calling us at 1-844-245-6868, or by calling 911.

If you find yourself in a situation where you are within 30 feet of downed wires, bunny hop or shuffle away keeping your feet close together. You can see examples of this by scanning the QR code or by visiting the safety section of our website.

Create defensible space to act as a buffer zone between your property and the surrounding wildland area. This may help to slow wildfire spread.

Have an emergency kit and keep it accessible for quick evacuation. Prepare for the possibility of being away from home for a while.
