Liberty's Water System

Liberty operates and maintains a complex water system so water is available to customers when they need it.

- 264 miles of pipeline

Building for the Future

Liberty diligently maintains the water system today to protect service for current and future generations. Deferring maintenance can undermine the reliability of the system over time and lead to unplanned disruptions from line breaks, which are more costly than planned replacements.



General Rate Case

Liberty filed a General Rate Case application on July 2, 2021 with the California Public Utilities Commission for the years 2022–2024. The application seeks funding for proposed infrastructure projects in 2022, 2023 and 2024 through a rate adjustment of 15.10% on July 1, 2022, 4.35% in 2023, and 4.00% in 2024 for residential and commercial customers.



Upcoming Projects

Proposed in the 2022-2024 General Rate Case

Liberty has proposed to invest nearly \$57.5 million for infrastructure improvements from 2021-2024.

- Replace approximately 8.1 miles of aging water main to improve system reliability
- Purchase groundwater basin water rights to gain water supply reliability
- Replace obsolete financial and work management systems to improve productivity and customer experience
- New water production facilities including the completion of a ground water well and rehabilitation of booster pump stations
- Install 256 fire hydrants to protect the community during fire events
- Replace/install 1,146 service connections throughout the system to minimize leaks and water loss
- Replace/install 164 water system valves
