This supplemental filing is being made to incorporate minor changes as discussed with the Water Division. This supplemental filing will replace Advice Letter 276-W in its entirety.

Summary

Liberty Park Water submits this advice letter to update the special conditions for Schedule No. PR-1-R, Residential Metered Service, Schedule No. PR-1-NR, Non-Residential Metered Service, Schedule No. PR-4F, Non-Metered Fire Sprinkler Service, Schedule No. PR-6, Reclaimed Water Service, and Schedule No. SC, Surcredit.

Background and Discussion

At the request of Water Division, Liberty Park Water proposes to delete Special Condition 22 in Schedule No. PR-1-R and Schedule No. PR-1-NR. Liberty Park Water also proposes to delete Special Condition No. 10 in Schedule PR-4F. In addition, Liberty Park Water proposes to re-number page 2 of Schedule No. PR-6. Lastly, Liberty Park Water proposes to delete Schedule No. SC. These special conditions have expired and are no longer in effect and therefore should be deleted.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 of General Order 96-B, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to General Rule 7.3 of General Order 96-B, Liberty Park Water requests this filing become effective May 1, 2017.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on May 18, 2017 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow Staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

NON-METERED FIRE SPRINKLER SERVICE
 (continued)

4. Service hereunder is for private fire protection systems to which no connections for other than fire protection purposes are allowed and which are regularly inspected by the underwriters having jurisdiction, are installed according to specifications of the utility, and are maintained to the satisfaction of the utility. The utility may install the standard detector type meter approved by the Board of Fire Underwriters for protection against theft, leakage or waste of water, and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
5. The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of its system.
6. Any unauthorized use of water, other than for fire extinguishing purposes, shall be charged for at the regular established rate as set forth under Schedule No. PR-1-NR, Nonresidential Metered Service including Special Condition No. 21, and/or may be the grounds for the immediate disconnection of the sprinkler service without liability to the Company.
7. The utility reserves the right to limit the installation of private fire hydrant service to such areas where public fire hydrant does not exist or where public fire hydrant service is limited in scope to the detriment of the applicant.
8. A late charge will be imposed per Schedule No. LC.
9. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
