

This supplemental filing is being made to incorporate comments from the Division of Water and Audits ("DWA"). This supplemental filing will replace Advice Letter 265-W in its entirety.

These tariffs are submitted as authorized by Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of D.16-01-009 dated January 14, 2016.

Purpose

Liberty Park Water is filing this advice letter to implement rates for 2016 as set out in Appendix B of D.16-01-009. Additionally, pursuant to sections 16.6 and 16.9 of the Settlement Agreement adopted by D.16-01-009, Liberty Park Water is updating the Preliminary Statement to reflect the implementation of the Group Pension Expense Balancing Account and the termination of the Military Family Relief Program ("MFRP") Memorandum Account.

Liberty Park Water is also including an update to the adopted quantities for the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism Balancing Account and the Modified Cost Balancing Account for 2016 contained in the Preliminary Statement.

Furthermore, Liberty Park Water is updating Schedule PR-9CM to remove the surcharges that have expired and are no longer in effect.

Finally, Liberty Park Water is deleting blank Tariff Sheet Nos. 1218-W, 1265-W, 1268-W, 1270-W, 1271-W, and 1272-W from the Table of Contents.

The effective date of these tariffs sheets shall be January 22, 2016. These tariff sheets are to be approved by the Commission's Division of Water and Audits. This filing complies with General Order 96-B.

Tier Designation

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Pursuant to the ALJ's ruling, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on January 22, 2016 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order,
- or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow Staff to properly consider the protest.


