

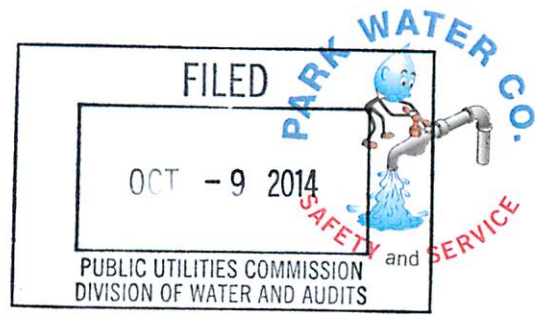

Purpose

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to Decision No. (D.)13-09-005, dated September 5, 2013, in Application No. (A.)12-01-001, filed January 3, 2012. Park is seeking authorization to include in rate base the costs of completed, operational, used and useful Well 19C capital project in Park's service area.

Background and Discussion

Ordering Paragraph No. 12 of D.13-09-005 directs Park to file a Tier 2 advice letter for the rate base offset of costs related to Well 19C and the associated generator. Specifically, Ordering Paragraph No. 12 states:

12. Park Water Company is authorized to file a Tier 2 advice letter for rate base offset of costs related to Well 19C and the associated generator, capped at the updated cost of \$1,380,991. 50.

Accordingly, Park is filing this advice letter to include in rate base and to recover the corresponding revenue requirement for the capital project in Park's service area. The capital project is Well 19C and the associated generator referenced in Ordering Paragraph No. 12 in D.13-09-005.

The authorized cap for the project and the respective actual cost is summarized in the table below.

The Well 19C project is used and useful, as of the filing date of this advice letter.		
Through this advice letter, Park is seeking to recover \$1,380,991.50, the authorized cap amount. The first year revenue requirement is \$238,857.		

Park is requesting an offset increase of \$238,857 or 0.76% of its 2014 adopted revenue requirement. Park proposes to recover the increase in revenue requirements through increases to the service charge and commodity rate in Schedule No. PR-1-R, Residential Metered Service, Schedule No. PR-1-NR, Non-Residential Metered Service, and Schedule No. PR-6, Reclaimed Water Service. Park also proposes to increase the service charge in Schedule No. PR-4F, Non-Metered Fire Sprinkler Service.

The Commission Staff has been provided with workpapers showing the development of the above amounts. The workpapers also show the development of proposed rates to allow for recovery of the increase in revenue requirement.

Bill Impact

The rate impact on the average residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter, who consumes average water use of 12 Ccf per month, would see an increase of \$0.50 or 0.67% per month.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to D.13-09-005, this advice letter is submitted with Tier 2 Designation.

Effective Date

Pursuant to Water Industry Rule 7.2 (2) of General Order 96-B, Park requests this filing become effective, subject to refund, on October 19, 2014. Water Industry Rule 7.2 - "Effective Date", item (2) states:

(2) Upon request and justification by the Utility, Staff may allow a Tier 2 advice letter to be made effective, subject to refund, in less than 30 days.

Park initially requested authorization to include in rate base the costs of completed, operational, used and useful Well 19C capital project, and incorporate the associated revenue requirement into rates, in its Advice Letter 253-W, filed on June 24, 2014. That advice letter was suspended by the Division of Water and Audits (DWA) for further review and rejected by DWA on August 28, 2014 due to an unresolved issue regarding application of the authorized cap. Subsequently, Park met with DWA to discuss the matter and has been informed that DWA agrees that the cap amount of \$1,380, 991.50 authorized in D.13-09-005, the same rate base amount for which offset was sought in Advice Letter 253-W, is the correct cap amount and was applied correctly by Park in its calculation of this rate base offset.

The rate base offset, based on the authorized cap, and the rates sought in this advice letter are the same as those requested in Advice Letter 253-W. The workpapers supporting the increase requested in this advice letter were thoroughly reviewed by DWA during its review of Advice letter 253-W. Advice Letter 253-W was served to the required service list, the same service list to which this advice letter is served, on June 24, 2014. Therefore the appropriate parties have already been provided an opportunity to protest this increase. No protests were received. This project has been completed, is used and useful, and has been closed to utility plant. Park was not authorized a memorandum account for this project and therefore Park has incurred unreimbursed costs, and received no return on its investment in this facility to provide service to ratepayers, and will continue to do so until this request is made effective. For all these reasons Park submits that no useful purpose will be served by requiring the effective date of this advice letter to be 30 days after filing and that an earlier effective date is justified.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on October 9, 2014 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Customer notification of this increase was previously accomplished in A.12-01-001 as required by Rule No. 3.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Additional public notice of this filing is not required.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
