#### TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Liberty Utilities (Park Water) Corp. (U 346-W) ("Liberty Park Water") respectfully submits the attached revised tariff sheets applicable to water service in its service territory.

#### **Summary**

This advice letter is submitted to revise Schedule No UF, Surcharge to Fund Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Account Fee ("PUCURA") user fees, to reflect the updated fee for Water Corporations for fiscal year 2022-2023.

On December 15, 2022, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) approved Resolution M-4866, in which it set forth the levels of PUCURA for fiscal year 2022-2023. Effective January 1, 2023, the current user fee of 1.43% will decrease to 0.8%.

#### **Background**

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) uses Public Utilities Code as the basis for its methodology to annually assess user fees for energy, water and telecommunication utilities.

#### Public Utilities Code Section 431 states:

- (a) The commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers or subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the commission other than a railroad, except as otherwise provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421).
- (b) The annual fee shall be established to produce a total amount equal to that amount established in the authorized commission budget for the same year, including adjustments for increases in employee compensation, other increases appropriated by the Legislature, and an appropriate reserve to regulate public utilities less the amount to be paid from special accounts or funds pursuant to Section 402, reimbursements, federal funds, and any other revenues, and the amount of unencumbered funds from the preceding year.
- (c) This article shall not apply to any electrical cooperative as defined in Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 2776) of Part 2.
- (d) On and after January 1, 1985, this article shall apply to radiotelephone utilities as defined in Section 4902 as those provisions read on December 31, 1984.
- (e) This section shall become operative on January 1, 2020.

## **Tier Designation**

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

#### **Effective Date**

Pursuant to Resolution M4866, Liberty Park Water requests the revised tariff become effective on January 1, 2023.

#### **Notice and Service**

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on December 16, 2023 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

#### **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order or is not authorized by statute or Commission order upon which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. This schedule is applicable within the entire territory serviced by the utility.

#### RATES

A 0.80% (0.0080) surcharge will be added to all customer bills.

In 1982, the Legislature established the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee to be paid by utilities to fund their regulation by the Commission (Public Utilities (PU)Code Section 401-443). The surcharge to recover the cost of that fee is ordered by the Commission under authority granted by the PU Code Section 433.
