Advice Letter No. 341-W

May 15, 2024

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Liberty Utilities (Park Water) Corp. (U 314-W) ("Liberty Park Water") hereby transmits the attached revised tariff sheets applicable to water service in its service territory.

Summary

The purpose of this advice letter is to implement rates for escalation year 2023 as authorized by the Commission in Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of D.23-02-003 (A.21-07-003, et al.).

The escalation year 2024 revenue increase of \$1,474,235 or 3.49% was calculated using the adopted quantities from D.23-02-003 in accordance with the procedures contained in the Rate Case Plan for Class A water utilities (D.07-05-062, Section VII. Escalation and Attrition Advice Letter Procedure). The Commission Staff has been provided with workpapers showing the calculation of the escalation year increase.

The adopted rate of return of 7.35%, specified in D.23-02-003 was adjusted to 7.65% to coincide with the pro-forma 12-month period ending March 31, 2024. A summary of earnings for this period, on both a pro-forma and recorded basis, is contained in the workpapers.

The pro-forma rate of return of 6.59% is less than the adjusted rate of return of 7.65% specified in D.23-02-003. A summary of earnings for this period, on both a pro-forma and recorded basis, is contained in the workpapers.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of D.23-02-003, this escalation filing is classified as a Tier 1 advice letter.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of D.23-02-003, Liberty Park Water requests this filing become effective July 1, 2024.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on May 15, 2024 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Customer notification of this rate increase was previously accomplished in A.21-07-003, et al. as required by Rule No. 3.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Additional public notice of this filing is not required.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Commission's Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
