Summary

The purpose of this filing is to update Liberty Park Water's Bellflower-Norwalk service area map to reflect the addition of a commercial customer. Southern California Edison ("SCE") has requested that Liberty Park Water provide fire protection service to its Center Peaker Generating Station ("CPGS"). Golden State Water Company ("GSWC"), who currently provides both domestic water and fire services, will continue to provide domestic water service only to this property.

Background and Discussion

In March 2020, SCE approached Liberty Park Water to inquire about increasing the fire flow to its CPGS located at 10601 Firestone Blvd., in the City of Norwalk. Currently, GSWC is providing domestic and fire protection service to this location. Liberty Park Water provides water service in the area adjacent to this location. SCE is proposing to construct new facilities at the CPGS property and the Los Angeles County Fire Department ("LACFD") is requiring a 1,500 gallons per minute ("gpm") fire flow as a condition of permitting the new facilities. GSWC cannot provide the increased fire flow requirements for the new facilities. Liberty Park Water is able to provide the fire flow requirements for the new facilities. At the recommendation of the LACFD, SCE has requested Liberty Park Water to provide its fire protection service to the CPGS.

Liberty Park Water has agreed to provide the fire protection service while GSWC will continue to provide the domestic water service to the CPGS.

Liberty Park Water is requesting to update its current Bellflower-Norwalk service area map to provide fire protection to the CPGS.

GSWC filed Advice Letter 1841-W, dated November 23, 2020, to update its Norwalk area map to provide domestic water service only to the CPGS.

The CPGS is shown on both Liberty Park Water and GSWC service area maps and is depicted with a distinct pattern for the purpose of identifying the property as receiving the dual/split services.

A copy of both SCE letter requesting fire protection service from Liberty Park Water and Liberty Park Water's fire flow test are provided as workpapers.

Tier Designation

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective Date

Liberty Park Water requests this filing become effective on January 1, 2020.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2, and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be electronically transmitted on December 3, 2020 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Liberty Park Water can only provide electronic copies of this advice letter to the service list. Pursuant to Water Industry Rule 3.2 of General Order 96-B, public notice is not required.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order or is not authorized by statute or Commission order upon which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. 
