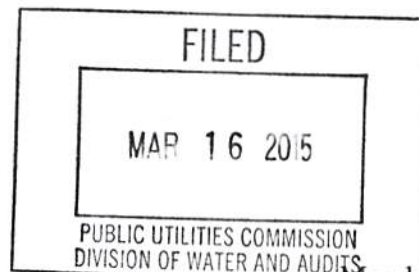

These tariffs are submitted as authorized by Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of D.16-02-014 dated February 19, 2016.

Purpose

Liberty Park Water is filing this advice letter to update the California Alternative Rates for Water Surcharge for 2016 as set out in Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of D.16-02-014.

Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of D.16-02-014 states the following:

5. The amount \$7.12 is changed to \$8.81 in the Discussion on page 11, Finding of Fact No. 14, and Ordering Paragraph No. 10.

With this correction, Ordering Paragraph No. 10 of D.16-01-009 states the following:

10. The monthly CARW surcharge is increased to \$8.81. This amount incorporates the \$526,141 under-collection in the CARW Revenue Allocation Balancing Account as of December 31, 2014.

These tariff sheets are to be approved by the Commission's Division of Water and Audits. This filing complies with General Order 96-B.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to D.16-02-014, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to General Rule 7.3.2 of General Order 96-B, Liberty Park Water requests that this filing become effective March 18, 2016.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on March 16, 2016 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow Staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

A surcharge of \$8.81 per month is applicable to all metered customers, excluding customers receiving Non-Metered Fire Sprinkler Service, Reclaimed Water Service, Construction and Other Temporary Metered Service, and customers that receive a CARW credit. The surcharge offsets CARW credits and CARW program costs and will be applied to each customer's bill. (I)
