The purpose of this advice letter is to implement rates for escalation year 2018 as authorized by the Commission in Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of D.16-01-009 (A.15-01-001) and D.16-02-014.

The escalation year 2018 revenue increase of \$1,530,624 or 4.05% was calculated using the adopted quantities from D.16-01-009 in accordance with the procedures contained in the Rate Case Plan for Class A water utilities (D.07-05-062, Section VII. Escalation and Attrition Advice Letter Procedure). The Commission Staff has been provided with workpapers showing the calculation of the escalation year increase.

The adopted rate of return of 9.07%, specified in D. 16-01-009 was adjusted to 9.35% to coincide with the pro-forma 12-month period ending September 30, 2017. A summary of earnings for this period, on both a pro-forma and recorded basis, is contained in the workpapers.

The pro-forma rate of return of 8.33% is less than the adjusted rate of return of 9.35% specified in D.16-01-009. A summary of earnings for this period, on both a pro-forma and recorded basis, is contained in the workpapers.

Liberty Park Water also includes an update to the adopted quantities for the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism Balancing Account and the Modified Cost Balancing Account for escalation year 2018 contained in the Preliminary Statement.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of D.16-01-009, Liberty Park Water also includes an update to the California Alternative Rates for Water discount and surcharge.

Liberty Park Water also submits this advice letter to update the special conditions for Schedule No. PR-1-R, Residential Metered Service, Schedule No. PR-1-NR, Non-Residential Metered Service, Schedule No. PR-4F, Non-Metered Fire Sprinkler Service, and Schedule No. PR-6, Reclaimed Water Service,

Liberty Park Water proposes to delete Special Conditions No. 20 and No. 23 in Schedule No. PR-1-R and Schedule No. PR-1-NR. Liberty Park Water also proposes to delete Special Condition No. 11 in Schedule PR-4F. In addition, Liberty Park Water proposes to delete Special Condition No. 6 in Schedule No. PR-6. These special conditions have expired and are no longer in effect and therefore should be deleted.

In accordance with Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 of General Order 96-B, this escalation filing is classified as a Tier 1 advice letter.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 4 of D. 16-01-009, Park requests this filing become effective January 1, 2018.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on November 15, 2017 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Customer notification of this rate increase was previously accomplished in A.15-01-001 as required by Rule No. 3.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Additional public notice of this filing is not required.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
