## **Outdoor watering**

On April 26, 2022, the Metropolitan Water District (MWD)—the agency that supplies imported water to much of Southern California—adopted new restrictions, including the limiting of outdoor watering to one day per week. This restriction is focused on portions of Los Angeles, Ventura, and San Bernardino counties that are served by MWD and heavily rely on the severely restricted State Water Project, which brings water from Northern California.

Liberty is not directly impacted by MWD's restrictions, as Liberty may access MWD's less restricted water supplies imported from the Colorado River, along with local groundwater supplies.

Liberty will continue to conserve and create programs for our customers to assist in your conservation journey as California continues to face dry conditions and drought. Our efforts to align with Governor Newsom's call for all California cities to save water are ongoing, and we will continue to update you as things progress.
