

Staying safe around electricity



Avoid overhead power lines

Planning a project that requires a ladder? Remember to always look up before starting work and **maintain at least 10 feet of clearance from overhead power lines.**

Overhead electrical wires can carry extremely high voltage and can be deadly if you come in contact with them.

Be aware of downed wires

If you see a downed wire, stay a minimum of 30 feet away, which is approximately the length of a school bus. Once you are a safe distance away, **report downed wires immediately by calling us at 1-844-245-6868, or by calling 911.** If you find yourself in a situation where you are within 30 feet of downed wires, bunny hop or shuffle away keeping your feet close together. Safe, sound, and underground

If your property has an underground electric service, you most likely have a box in your yard mounted on a cement or fiberglass pad. That box is called a transformer and it reduces the voltage coming from our distribution lines before entering your home.

In the event of an emergency, or other issues with your service line, our crews need immediate access to your transformer. Please do not place vegetation, or other material, 10 feet in front of the transformer's doors and 4 feet around the other three sides. Also, be sure to never sit or climb on top of the transformer or store items on or around it.
