PROCEEDING INFORMATION

On May 1, 2018, Liberty Utilities (Park Water) Corp. (Liberty Park Water) filed Application A.18-05-006 with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting authority to decrease its authorized cost of capital and rate of return. This application covers the years 2019, 2020 and 2021. Liberty Park Water's application requests a decrease to the authorized rate of return from the current 9.07% to 8.11%. If the CPUC approves this request, Liberty Park Water's revenues would decrease by \$1,510,000 or 3.98% beginning January 1, 2019.

Any of the five CPUC Commissioners may sponsor an alternate decision. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted on at a scheduled CPUC Voting Meeting.
