




Solar Incentive Program (SIP) Available



Liberty's Solar Incentive Program (SIP) is part of our commitment to renewable energy and supports the development of distributed generation systems for residential, small business and school customers within our service territory.

-  SIP provides a one-time payment to help offset installation costs, and is available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
-  SIP participants must have their application accepted and approved by Liberty Utilities **BEFORE** they install their system in order to be eligible for the incentive.
-  All systems must be net metered.

What are the eligibility requirements?

- ☀️ Residential and small business customers within Liberty Utilities' service territory are eligible to apply, as are all schools (K-12, higher education, public or private).
- ☀️ All systems must be permitted and inspected by the local building authority, and a licensed California contractor must complete the interconnection to the customer service panel. Equipment (both modules and inverters) must be listed on the California Energy Commission's eligible equipment list.
- ☀️ Solar systems may be sized to offset up to 100% of the customer's annual requirements for electricity, as measured by historical consumption.

What are the incentives?

- ☀️ The incentive is calculated by the size of the installed solar system (up to \$1.10 per Watt AC, with a maximum of \$11,000). Participants may install systems larger than the maximum incentive, but the incentive will be limited to the maximum amount.
- ☀️ **Important:** Customers must apply for and be approved by Liberty Utilities **BEFORE** installation of their system in order to qualify for any incentive payment. There are no exceptions to this requirement.
- ☀️ The Solar Incentive Program has 250 kW of available capacity for 2020. See the latest available capacity on the online application page: <https://libertycasolar.powerclerk.com/MvcAccount/Login>.
