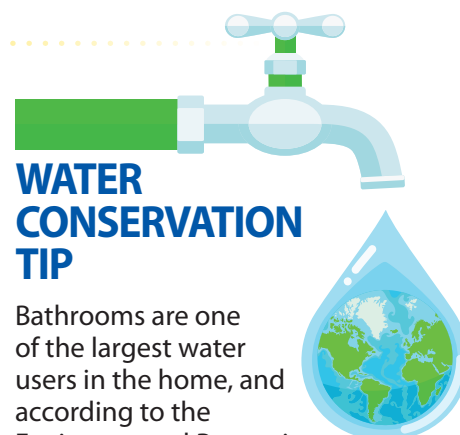
Sarah Rae, Conservation

WATER CONSERVATION TIP

Bathrooms are one of the largest water users in the home, and according to the Environmental Protection Agency, they account for more than half of all the water that families use indoors. Did you know, if you live in an apartment, your building may qualify for an ultra-high efficiency toilet? Liberty has recently launched a Multi-Family Retrofit Program in which high usage multi-family apartment buildings with existing water wasting toilets of 3 - 7 gallons per flush may be eligible for new WaterSense approved 0.8 GPF Ultra High Efficiency Toilets.
